Mapping the Mills: Explore the Industrial Heritage of the River Wandle

WALKS PROGRAMME*: SPRING 2018

THURSDAY 12 APRIL

WALK 1: Earlsfield Station to the Causeway, Wandsworth

This walk explores the significance of the Wandle in establishing a millennium-long tradition of flour milling in Wandsworth.

Meeting Point: Earlsfield Station, Garratt Lane, SW18 4SR (Buses: 44, 77, 270)

End: The Causeway, Wandsworth, SW18 1ER (Wandsworth Town Station, Buses: 26, 37, 39, 44, 87, 156, 170, 270, 337)

Time: 10.30 – 12.00 approximately

THURSDAY 19 APRIL

WALK 2: Watermeads to Morden Hall Park

On this walk some of the best-preserved industrial heritage on the River Wandle will be encountered.

Meeting Point: Watermeads Nature Reserve, SM4 6BF (Mitcham Tram Stop, Buses: 116, 280)

End: Morden Hall Snuff Mills, Morden Hall Park, Morden Hall Road, SM4 5JD (Morden Underground Station, Buses: 60, 118, 154, 157, 164, 201, 470, K5)

Time: 10.30 – 12.00 approximately

THURSDAY 3 MAY

WALK 3: High Street Carshalton to Hackbridge

This walk celebrates the power of water within the historic industries of the River Wandle.

Meeting Point: outside the Coach and Horses pub, 12 High Street, Carshalton, SM5 3AG (Carshalton Station, Buses: 127, 157, 407, X26)

End: Hackbridge, Hackbridge Road, SM5 2DD (Hackbridge Station, Buses: 80, 127 151)

Time: 10.30 – 12.00 approximately

THURSDAY 10 MAY

WALK 4: Morden Hall Park to Colliers Wood

Discover how industries used the Wandle and its surrounding landscape, and view the contrast between homes of mill owners and workers.

Meeting Point: Morden Hall Snuff Mills, Morden Hall Park, Morden Hall Road, SM4 5JD (as Walk 2)

End: 1 Merton High Street, Colliers Wood, SW19 1DD (Colliers Wood Underground Station, Buses: 57, 131, 152, 200, 210, 470)

Time: 10.30 – 12.00 approximately
